Dear IEEE Signal Processing Society Member,

I am writing to let you know that, as an IEEE member in good standing for five or more years, you meet one of the eligibility requirements to be considered for IEEE Senior Member grade. As a longtime member, you've demonstrated that IEEE membership is valuable to you personally and professionally. By applying for elevation to IEEE Senior Member, you can continue to receive career-enhancing resources, as well as exclusive benefits and professional advancement opportunities.

IEEE Senior Member is the highest member grade for which one can apply, as opposed to be nominated. Only IEEE Senior Members are eligible to be considered for IEEE Fellow designation, the highest and most prestigious of IEEE member grades. According to the IEEE bylaws, in order to qualify for IEEE Senior Member, a candidate must:

- be an engineer, scientist, educator, technical executive, or originator in [IEEE-designated fields](#);
- have experience reflecting professional maturity;
- have been in professional practice for at least ten years;
- have shown significant performance over a period of at least five of those years;
- provide three references from current IEEE members holding Senior, Fellow, or Honorary member grades.

Significant performance can include noteworthy job and leadership responsibilities, research, course and research development, publication of papers, technical contributions, and more. Additionally, qualified performance needn't have occurred in the years immediately preceding application – members in all professional stages, including Life and Retired members, are encouraged to apply.
